The states of Idaho, North Dakota and Vermont submit this joint letter indicating intent to dissolve the Internet Unemployment System (iUS) Consortium. This dissolution will take effect upon the termination of the Consortium's Memorandum of Understanding among the three states, which will occur following the resolution of certain contractual obligations.

The three states have agreed to work together to ensure a positive separation for all and are working diligently to bring closure to several outstanding items.

Regarding the request for information pertaining to grant products and deliverables, anticipated next steps, contract resolution, shutdown termination costs, and financial accounting, each state will be providing state-specific data as requested via separate communication to the grant officer.
